

The Butternut Valley Rural Community Council 2026 Scholarship Program

Butternut Valley Rural Community Council is pleased to be able to offer two scholarships valued at \$2500 to qualifying students who live within Butternut Valley.

Qualified applicants must be accepted to a full-time program at a post-secondary institution within Canada beginning in September 2026.

Qualifying applicants must be enrolled in a program focused on agriculture, forestry, environmental science, or emergency services/first response. Emergency services/first response includes fire services, police services, and paramedical services.

Eligibility

Applicants must be at least 17 years of age

Applicants must be Canadian citizens and full-time residents of Butternut Valley

Applicants must be starting or continuing a full-time program of study at a Canadian Post Secondary Institution in September 2026

Applicants must complete the application available to download or print at: butternutvalley.ca and include the following:

- Answers to *all* questions in the application
- A letter of offer or letter of acceptance to the full-time program
- A transcript of marks from the most recently completed school term
- A short summary of community involvement/volunteer experience
- A letter of recommendation from a non-relative who can speak to the applicant's passion or interest in pursuing post secondary education in agriculture, forestry, environmental science, or emergency services/first response. Emergency services/first response includes fire services, police services, and paramedical services

Successful recipients will grant Butternut Valley permission to use their name and the details of the program and institution they will be attending in meeting minutes, online at butternutvalley.ca and on the Butternut Valley Facebook account.

Selection Criteria

In 2026, applications will be reviewed by an appointed selection committee and assessed on the criteria outlined above.

Two scholarships of \$2,500 each will be awarded in 2026. **Applications close at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 10, 2026.** Submissions may be sent by email to info@butternutvalley.ca or by mail to 2002 Route 885, Havelock, NB E4Z 5M7.
