



Sussex Vale Quilters' Guild Scholarship Award Guidelines

The following conditions and regulations will be considered in selecting the recipient of this award. One Sussex Vale Quilters' Guild Scholarship valued at \$500.00 will be awarded yearly to a student graduating from high school.

Who can Apply: Current graduating students of Belleisle Regional High School, Sussex Christian School, Petitcodiac Regional High School or Sussex Regional High School who plans to attend a fully accredited post-secondary institution in the fall of graduating year.

Application: Applications must include:

1. Acceptance letter or conditional acceptance from a post-secondary institution;
2. A sample of the fibre art(s) of interest to the student;
3. Completed application.

Criteria: The intent of this award is to help a Belleisle Regional High School, Sussex Christian School, Petitcodiac Regional High School or Sussex Regional High School student, who wants to further their education in the field of fibre art(s). This could include graphic design, textile design, fashion design, textile restoration, costuming and other related programs.

Due Date: Completed Applications are due the fourth Friday of May at 12pm to Sussex Area Community Foundation Inc.

This scholarship is administered by Sussex Area Community Foundation and available from a generous donation by members of the Sussex Vale Quilters' Guild.

The award will be forwarded to the recipient's college or university account once proof of attendance, the address of the university/college's financial office, student number, full name, email, telephone, address and social insurance number is received by SACFI from the recipient.
